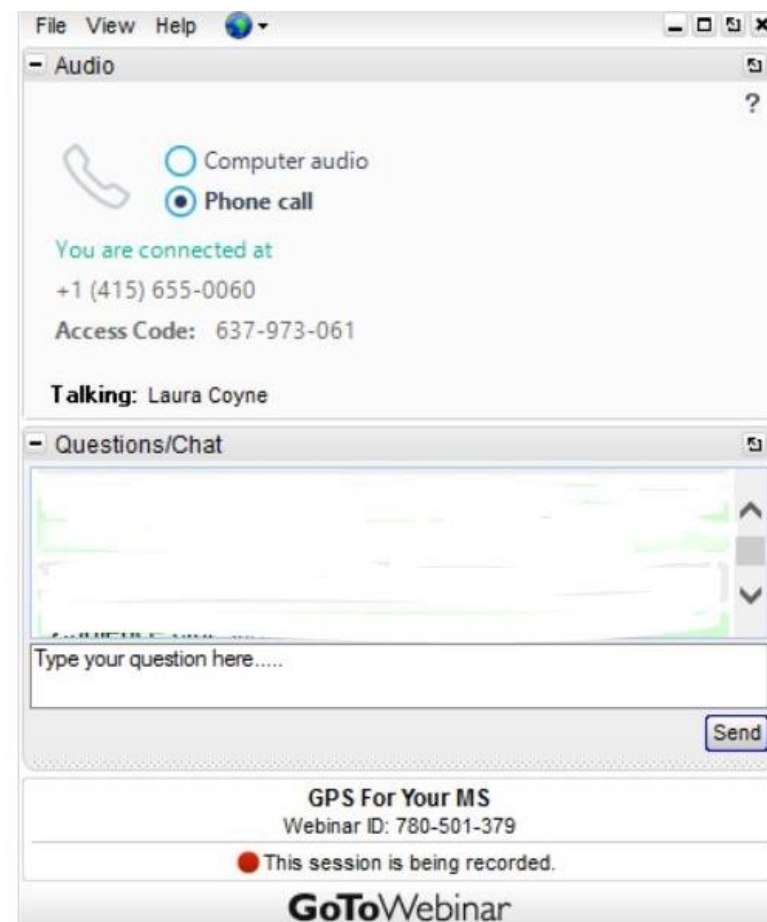

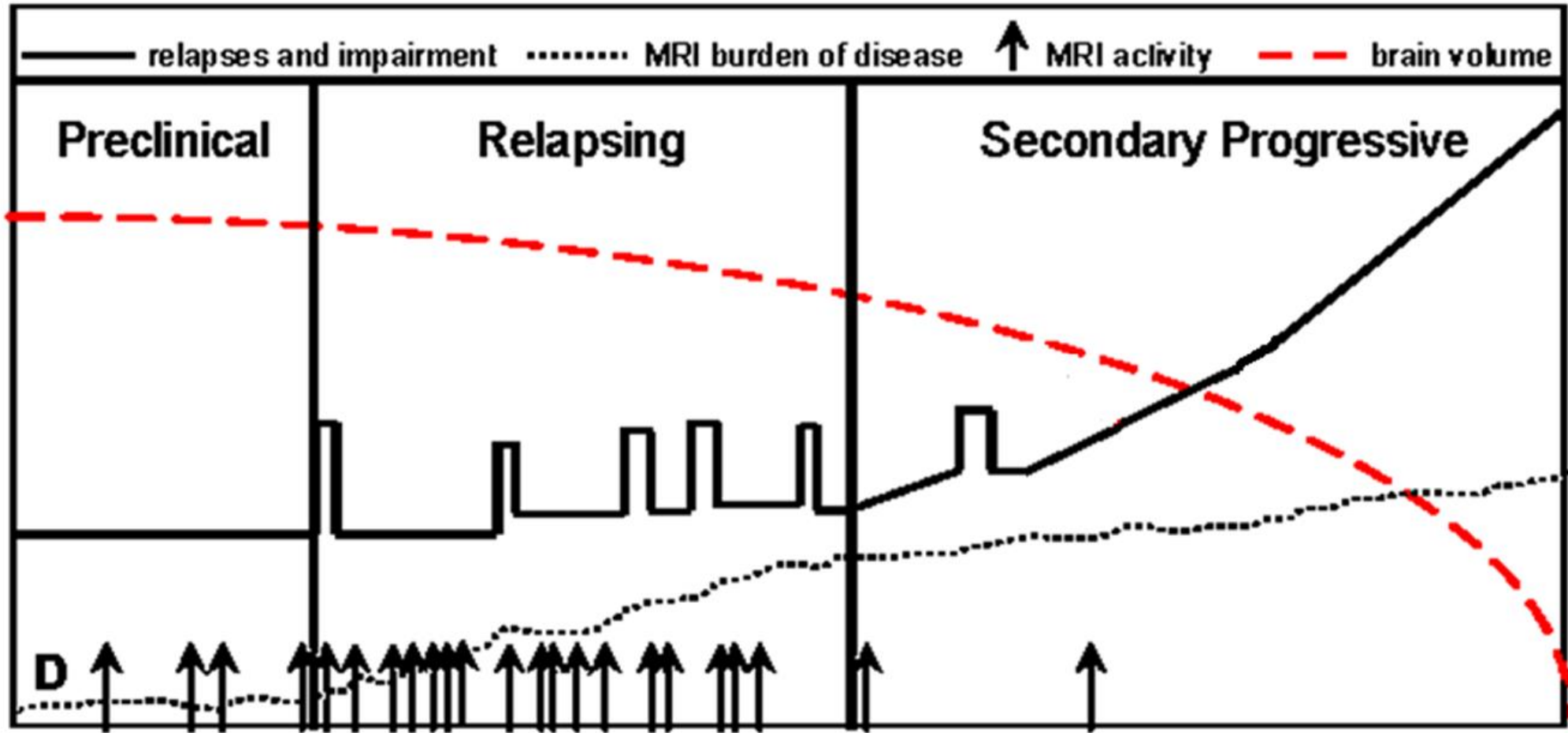

Course of MS Symptoms



Multiple Sclerosis – Two Different Processes

Relapsing–Remitting MS and **Progressive MS** differ in:

- **Age** – Relapsing Remitting in younger people and Progressive (primary or secondary) in older people.
 - Largely due to age-related changes in the immune system.
- **Pathology** – Immune system behaves differently

New terminology stresses whether disease is *active* (with exacerbations) and whether it is *progressive*.

What Does MS Comprehensive Care Include?

- **MANAGING the disease**

- Early and ongoing treatment with a disease-modifying therapy

- **MONITORING the disease**

- Determining the effects of treatment

- **MANAGING relapses**

- Corticosteroids
- Rehabilitation

- **ALLEVIATING symptoms**

- Medications
- Rehabilitation strategies

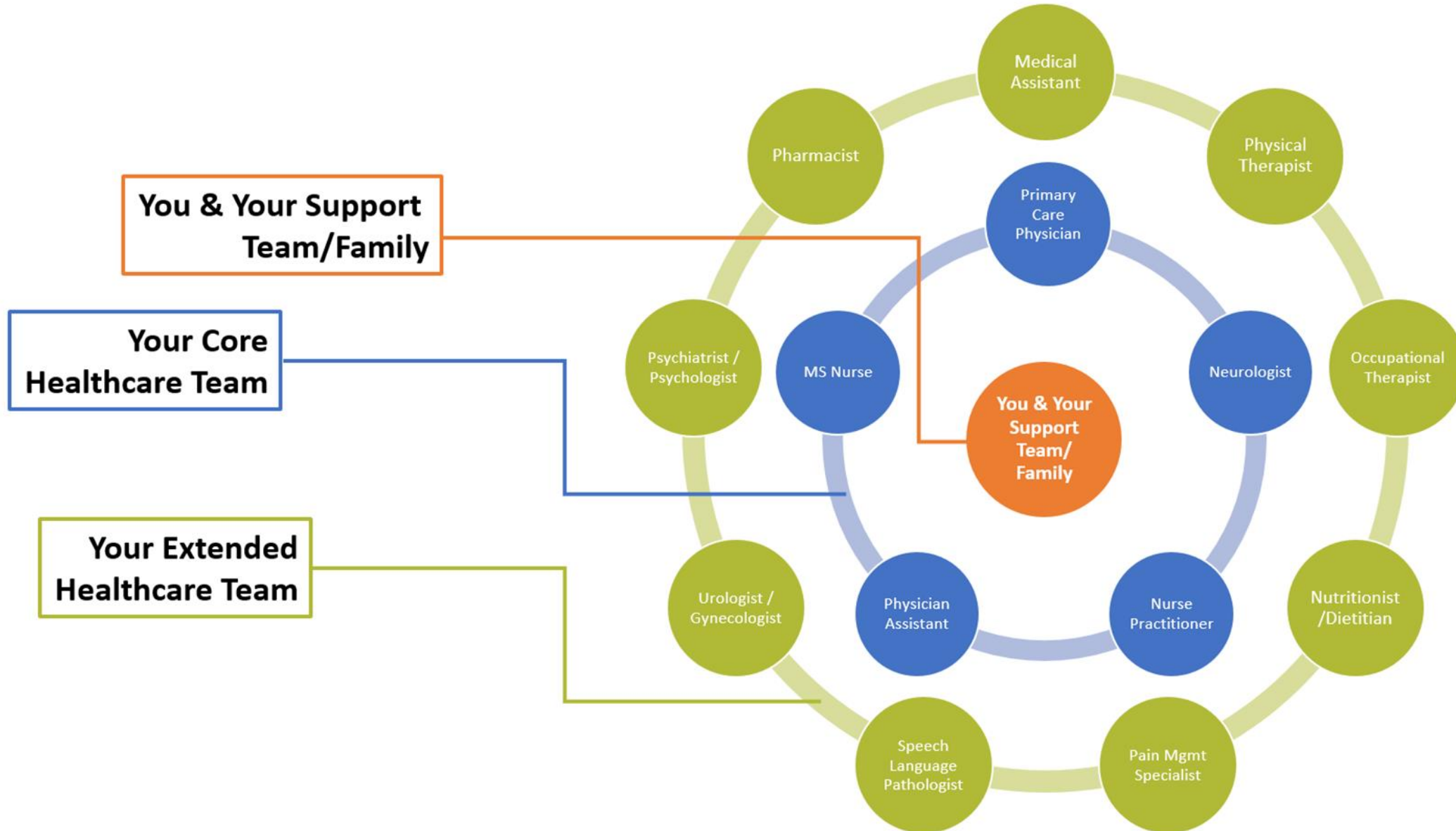
- **OPTIMIZING function with rehabilitation**

- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech/language therapy

- **SUPPORTING emotional well-being**

- Mental health professionals
- Family and friends
- Each other

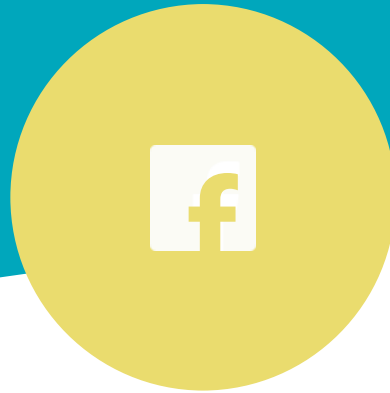
